In Science the children will learn about:

- Colour mixing skills using powder paint.

- Exploring and creating our own art work focusing on the work of Barbara Hepworth and William Scott.

In music, we will be making and using sounds expressively using various percussion instruments.

As well as games and gymnastics, we will be exploring expressive dance routines in P.E.
