Areas of Learning

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

During this term the children will be focusing on:

- Following the Nursery Rules and Routines.

- Developing their confidence and independence.

Communication and Language

The children will learn to:

- Listen with interest to stories read to them.
- Join in with songs and rhymes.
- Listen and identify different sounds.
- Share their experiences with others.

Physical Development

This term the children will be learning to:

- Climb confidently and begin to pull themselves up onto the nursery's climbing equipment.
- Be able to stop when asked to by an adult.
- Use a three fingered tripod grasp when holding writing tools.

Literacy

The children will be learning to:

- Handle books carefully and independently.
- Repeat words from stories they know.
- Distinguish between the different marks they make.

Mathematics

This term the children will be learning to:

- Count through Number Puppies, various activities, songs and number rhymes.
- Use number names while they play.
- Recognise the shapes circle, square, triangle, rectangle, hexagon, pentagon, octagon, oval, trapezium and rhombus.
- Use size language e.g. big, tall, medium, small and tiny.

Understanding the World

We will be learning to:

- Complete a simple computer program using our computers and I Pads.
- Take photographs using our digital cameras and I Pads.
- Explore the indoor and outdoor nursery environment.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be learning to:

- Join in singing Nursery Rhymes.
- Identify the colours green, yellow, red, blue, pink, purple, orange, grey, white, brown and black.
- Explore mixing the colours using paints.
- Use their imaginations to act out various characters in our role play areas.
