# Year 1

#### Thís Week...

Year 1 have been reciting poetry in English this week. We enjoyed practising and performing poems to our friends. We also wrote our own poem called 'Wonderful Me' this week using interesting adjectives to describe ourselves. In maths this week we have been investigating doubles and near doubles using our Rekenreks. We have started a new unit in Computing this week called 'Lego Builders' where we are examining the importance of algorithms. In PE we have began a new unit called 'Sending and Receiving'; this week the children practised sending their ball to their friend accurately.











#### Thís Week...

This week has been our Geography Week. We have learned about the Earth's continents and oceans; the climate of different countries and which animals live in these parts of the world.

In English, we have continued with our genre – Fiction: Stories with familiar settings. We have planned and written our own versions of 'The Hungry Giant', with our own alternative characters and settings.

In maths we have focussed on multiplication strategies, particularly using a number line to help us to count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
